

Scoreline Sports: Covid Safe Management Plan (Update 6 August 2020)

This Covid-safe plan is for indoor sports activities undertaken by Scoreline Sports Pty Ltd. It is designed to meet or exceed standards outlined in the Queensland Government's Stage 3 Return to Play protocols. This plan is designed to be applied across all venues used by Scoreline Sports. A more specific version will be supplied for each venue, taking into account the various venue layouts, and venue management requirements.

1. Risk assessment

Scoreline Sports Covid Safe Management Plan (cont'd)

2. Actions

SCORELINE SPORTS MANAGEMENT:

1. Provide hand sanitizer, disinfectant and other necessary safety supplies
2. Inform and remind officials and players about Covid-safe protocols.
3. Keep contact details and attendance times of all attendees, and provide these for contact tracing if required.
4. Ensure that attendee numbers are well within the stage 3 requirements of 1 person per 4 square metres (Scoreline Sports internal standard is max 10 persons per team for Futsal, Basketball, Netball or Volleyball)
5. Provide details of physical distancing requirements, including notifying participants of designated waiting areas, maximum numbers, and entry and exit requirements.
6. Monitor players and officials to ensure that protocols are followed
7. Any additional requirements by venue management to be added to Covid Safe Plan and enforced.

PARTICIPANTS:

1. Be *registered* BEFORE attending (using our online registration)
2. See an official to get name ticked off when entering the venue.
3. Wait in designated zone until given all-clear to enter playing area.
4. Do not attend: if you feel unwell, or within two weeks after exposure to a known case, or of travelling overseas, or travelling in a “hotspot” area in Australia.
5. Come dressed ready to participate (no changing on-site).
6. Bring own water bottle (avoid use of water fountain)
7. Maintain physical distancing (1.5m), when not playing.
8. Sanitize hands before entering, and when leaving
9. If requiring toilet, use only the toilets designated for your playing area.
10. Please leave the venue as soon as possible after your game.

MATCH OFFICIALS:

1. Comply with protocols as per participants
2. Sanitize equipment including balls, goalposts, score table, after each game or practice
3. Sanitize hands after each game
4. Assist Scoreline Sports Management to enforce protocols.

PARTICIPANTS AGREEMENT

All participants and officials must agree to:

- Comply with safety directives issues by Scoreline Sports management, venue management and government health officials.
- Comply with testing measures if required by Scoreline Sports management or Government officials, and co-operate with contact tracing officials.
- Act with honesty and integrity in relation to personal health, and possible contacts with Covid-19

This plan is subject to amendment from time to time as required.
